¹¹ Crowl recalls that Griffiths asked him to write a second piece for the group (after *Canticae et Diverbia*), but for smaller forces. Excited by Pacheco's playing, Crowl scored *Ludus* for clarinettist and cellist, however changes in the group's personnel in 1990 meant that *Ludus* was never programmed. Viktor Kugai and Andrei Berezin premiered *Ludus* in Moscow in 2015.

¹² *Aroe Maiwu* and *Où sont les gracieux galants* were commissioned to mark Grupo Novo Horizonte's tenth anniversary. 1999, however, saw the group scale back its activities so neither piece was performed. Victorio recast *Aroe Maiwu* to form the final part of the *Trilogia Bororo* (2001–11), based on the composer's research of the tribal culture of the Bororo people of Mato Grosso. Grupo Sextante gave its premiere at the XIX Bienal de Música Contemporânea in Rio de Janeiro in 2011. At the same event in 2013, Dottori's *Où sont les gracieux galants* was premiered by an ensemble consisting of Maria Carolina Cavalcanti (fl), Paulo Passos (bcl), José Ricardo Taboada (va), Nailson Simões (tpt), Katia Baloussier (pf) and Daniel Serale (mba).
