Hindus Tear Down Mosque, Setting Off a Crisis in India

India, to begin construction of a temple in the Hindu god Ram, also called Rama, and to destroy the mosque of Babar. Hindu fundamentalists say the mosque was built on a sacred Hindu site, the very spot where Ram was born.

The mosque has been an important holy site for Muslims since it was built in 1528 by the Emperor Babar, who led the Muslim conquest of India.

No longer in use

The mosque was no longer used for prayers, but Muslims had returned to religious courses of the building, fearing that this could lead to the displacement of Muslim workers throughout India.

India's Supreme Court ruled last week that there should be no construction of the temple.
